B Finance**Chairman: Ian Ritchie**

- a. **2008 – 9 Budget.** This was proposed by I. Ritchie and seconded by P. Court. Unanimously approved. **Action: Clerk to fill in and submit precept form.**
- b. **New deposit account offered by Alliance and Leicester.** The new account is for parish councils and similar organisations and offers a higher interest rate than the business deposit account that the PC currently has. **Action: I. Ritchie to fill in as much of application forms as possible and hand to clerk for completion. Account signatories will have to fill in form as previously.**
- c. **VDS account.** This is to be closed and funds transferred to the PC's current account. **Action: Clerk.**

C Rights of way**Chairman: Graeme Fearon**

- a. **Proposed upgrading of byways 8/28 and 46 (Preston to Baydon) to allow Byway open to all traffic (BOAT).** **Action. I. Ritchie to object to this application as it is invalid having been requested outside the time limit for such applications.** There is a further list of similar applications. **Action: I. Ritchie to ask that all applications made outside the time limit be struck off the list.**
- b. **Cycle Route to Marlborough.** While the AONB is supportive of the application they have no funding this year. They asked that the PC to demonstrate that the route would be well supported by villagers, and to be willing to provide some interpretation of the landscape along the route. **Actions: 1. I. Ritchie to provide clerk with response of Sustrans to an application for funding. 2. Clerk to forward this response to Cllr Humphries. 3. I. Ritchie to write to the Ramsbury Manor land agent and WCC Highways regarding the proposed route.**
- c. **The Fence at Bolstridge Farm.** Repairs are to be carried out.
- d. **Manor Lane Footpath (no. 2).** Quotes for re-grading the footpath are awaited.

D Play Areas and Seats.**Chairman: Paul Court**

- a. Painting play equipment.** Supplies of paint etc have been provided free of charge by a local supplier. The painting will be done in Spring.
- b. Trees for Ashley Piece Play Area.** 1 Copper beech and 1 Acer Platanoides Drumondii are to be ordered. **Actions:** 1. S. Glass to contact P. Swan to see if the trees can be ordered for delivery with those arriving for project 2005's planting weekend in early December. 2. S. Glass to contact M. Abel for tree supports. 3. P. Court to liaise with S Glass and dig holes for the trees.
- c. Seat for outside Memorial Hall.** **Action: S. Glass to order bench.**
- d. Baby Swing (1.8 single bay) at Ashley Piece.** The orange crotch strap is broken. **Action: Clerk to order replacement from Playforce in Bath.**
- e. Fencing Knowledge Crescent Play Area.** Quotes are being sought.

E Emergency Committee.**Chairman: Chris Morgan**

- a. Emergency Plan.** The revised plan has been re-issued. **Action: C. Morgan to e-mail updated plan to P. Court.**
- b. Emergency exercise.** Will take place on Monday 26th November at 7.30 in the Parish Council Office. **Action: C. Morgan to e-mail out details to emergency committee.** P. Court apologised that he will be unable to attend.

F School Governor**Governor: Tim McQue**

- a. Funds.** The government proposal to take back 5% of funds held in school accounts in April 2006 has been dropped.
- b. Deputy head.** Marcia Northeast, Deputy Head Teacher will leave the school at the end of December to take up a Head Teacher post at another school.
- c. Administration Officer/Bursar/Clerk to the Governors.** The school has appointed a replacement for Mrs Stagg.
- d. Teaching assistant.** A new teaching assistant is being sought.
- e. Vandalism.** There have been two cases of vandalism in the past month at the school involving criminal damage. The police have been informed.
- f. Newsletter.** **Action: S. Findlay to request that the Parish Council is included in the distribution list.**

G Recreation Centre.**Chairman: George Hawes**

- a. Tree Planting.** The next wave of tree planting will take place in early December.
- b. Funding.** There is to be a Project 2005 meeting regarding potential funding. It is possible that the PC maybe asked to write a letter of support for a funding application.

H Policy Committee. Nothing to report**Chairman: Sheila Glass****7 Public Forum - Standing orders suspended for this item.**

- a.** Ben Tottenham congratulated the Parish Council on the completion of the millennium project which had improved the Square.
- b.** Ben Tottenham requested information on the proposed cycle route to Marlborough for the diary, through which he hopes to elicit support.
- c.** Ben Tottenham warned that the transformer at the sub-station in Loves lane was to be replaced w/c 19th November, necessitating a 40' vehicle reversing up Loves Lane. He had warned local residents and the school that vehicles should not be parked opposite Loves Lane at this time or the truck will not get through.
- d.** S. Judge reported that the stiles on paths 10 and 12 to the access land are unsafe. **Action: Clerk to get location details from S. Glass and report to Esther Daly.**

8 Axford**Geoff Treherne**

Road signs. A new 'Axford – Please drive carefully' sign, plus 'No footpath' signs have been installed. **Action: Clerk to write to WCC Highways request a 'No footpath' sign for Back Lane, Ramsbury.**

9 Nature Reserve.**Chris Morgan**

Gate and Walkway. A contractor has been arranged to undertake the work that will enable pushchair and wheelchair access.

10 Square refurbishment.

Geoff Rissone

New paving around tree. Despite delays in delivering the full amount of the correct stone, the work is now complete other than the removal of the wrongly delivered granite sets. The contractor has been told that payment will be made when this has been done. G. Rissone was formally thanked by the Parish Council for his hard work on this project, particularly in the face of the many difficulties that arose with the contract. **Action: G. Rissone to document the principles of the lessons learned for use with future projects.**

11 Purchase of land - Kennet Triangle at 2 Bridges, Mill Lane.

Legal Documents. Draft purchase and trust documents have been received. The land will be owned jointly by ARK and the PC. The PC is to request a small amendment to the trust document to clarify what will happen should ARK cease to exist. The documents will be signed by S. Glass and G. Fearon on behalf of the Parish Council and by trustees of ARK.

12 Public Conveniences.

A working party has cleared the roof of Russian Vine. Possibly as a result of the vine, some roof tiles are loose.

Action: P. Court to inspect roof.

13 Quality Court Axford.

This was erroneously included in a list of KDC assets for disposal in which the PC was invited to show interest. In fact, the only item in the Parish for disposal is the Sewage Works in Axford, which the PC agreed it had no interest in acquiring. **Action: Clerk to respond.**

14 High Street Parking.

- a. Leaflets.** Residents are to be leafleted at Christmas again this year, requesting that they and their guests ensure that the fire engine will not be hindered by parked cars. **Action: S. Glass.**
- b. Incidents associated with events at Holy Cross.** The School bus was delayed by 45 minutes when it was unable to get along Back Lane at the end of a School Day, and on 4th November the fire engine was significantly delayed in attending an emergency. **Action: G. Hawes to ask PCC to make events organisers aware of the need to avoid causing obstructions when parking.**

15 Parish Stewards Visit

- a. Service.** Despite the press release praising the new system, the Parish council's experience has been that the service is not as good as the previous lengthsman service. **Action: Cllr Humphries to pass on the PC's comments to WCC Highways.**
- b. Visit on 21st November.** This scheduled visit will not take place, as the parish steward is off sick for a month. **Action: Requests for work should be submitted to Clerk as normal for passing on to WCC, in case of another steward being free.**

16 Police Information Box. Awaiting fitting of new lock.

17 Vandalism.

2 incidents of vandalism have occurred at the school (See item 6F) and a pane of glass has been broken at the Memorial Hall.

18 Memorial Hall.

A new caretaker/cleaner/booking clerk is now in post.

19 The Youth Club. Nothing to report.

20 Oral History.

Art work for the CD is awaited. As a result the CD will not be ready for Christmas sale, but will be launched in conjunction with the Route to Victory event.

21 Street Lighting.

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Christmas Tree Lights. There have been problems getting the usual permission to connect to the lamp column in the Square (which is the responsibility of KDC). **Action: S. Findlay to contact Mark Smith of KDC to expedite the matter.**
