Update on parking/meeting with Martin Cook 8/3/19

- SG had met with KA and MC for a very positive meeting. There would be zig zag yellow lines on (i) both sides of Back Lane in front of the Pre School. White line in front of Mardle House. White lines in Isles Rd in front of the hedge opposite the school and on the school side up to the school car park. The buff crossing in Back Lane would be renewed and have bollards and a new crossing in Isles Rd is proposed (see Item 11).
- The beech bush opposite the school SG has asked C George, Isles Court warden, if it could be (ii) cut down to half a metre high so that children would be visible over the top of it. C George said she would write to Cognatum and talk to the Isles Court gardener. Unfortunately KA reported that C George has informed her that she has no intention of doing this.
- There would be white lines on both sides of Newtown Rd. from Ravensfield to Peter's Cottage. (iii) This visually narrows the road and should slow down the traffic.
