Susie Watson Design – CP had talked to Stephanie and with apologies, he was told that Hills had not emptied the bin on the correct day and that the bin will be removed and the matter will be taken up with Hills. Since then no problems with the red topped bin.

The Bell – since the letter from the Parish Council had been sent to the Bell, the bins have been put out and removed when emptied and not left on the street.

The Post Office – The bins had been moved back, but now there is building work going on and they are forward again.
