EH shared the principles of the precept request for FY19/20 as aligned with the Finance committee

The intent is to increase the precept request to $\pounds 52,000$ (last year we were awarded $\pounds 51,015$). This Allows for:

• Continued increased donations to the Flyer (£4000). WC are continuing to cut funding to organisations such as the flyer, and as such we would like to ensure we plan in advance for any potential further cuts to this.

- Funding for the Axford Internet scheme (£3000) as approved in the Sept 2017 meeting for 3 consecutive years
- Funding for pavements £9000 (to continue improving pavements in the village as we have seen over the past couple of years, this is not being funded by WC and therefore we will request within the precept as transferred responsibilities)
- $\circ\quad \pounds 2000$ for Traffic needs (School area and Axford as needed)
